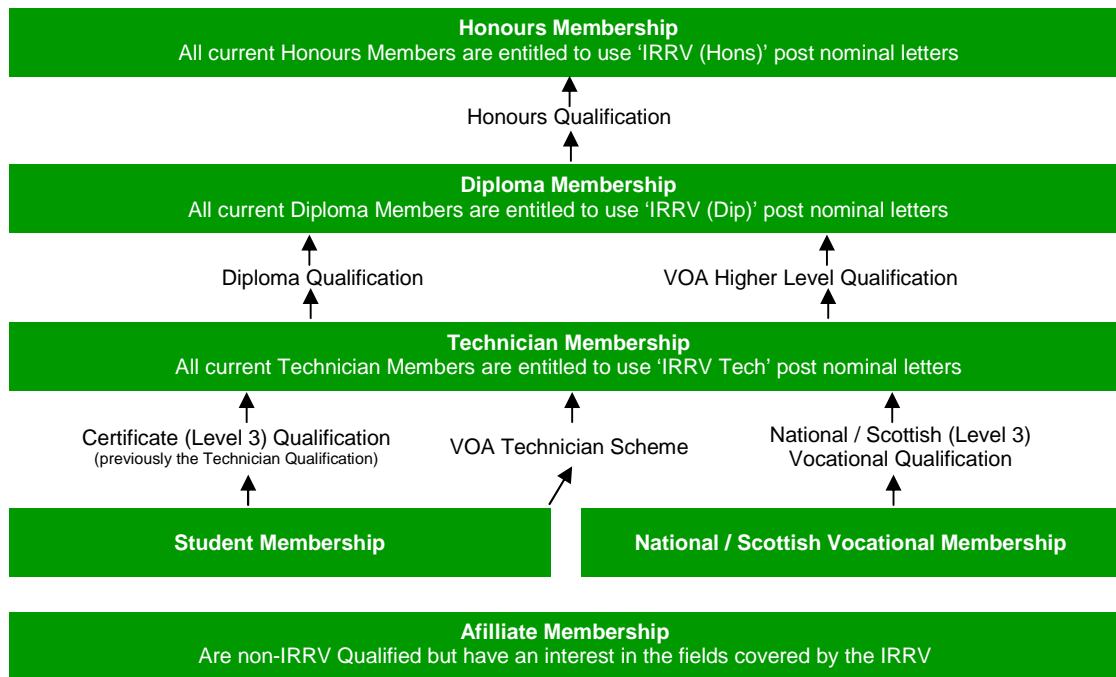


# Categories of Membership and Fees

IRRV Member grades are structured in a way to ensure that there is a grade of membership for everyone working in local authorities and public and private sector valuation. Most new members of the IRRV will join as an Affiliate, Vocational or Student Member.

The diagram below illustrates the routes to IRRV Membership through Qualifications (effective 1 January 2010).



## Categories of Membership

**Honours Members** have passed or been exempted from the Full Professional or Honours qualification

**Diploma Members** have passed the Diploma qualification

**Technician Members** have passed the Technician qualification

**Graduate Members** hold a BSc in Estates Management and are working towards the IRRV Test of Professional Competence

**Student Members** are studying for IRRV qualifications

**NVQ/SVQ Candidate Members** are working for NVQs/SVQs

**Affiliate Members** are non-IRRV qualified but have an interest in the fields covered by IRRV

**Retired Members** have retired from professional work
