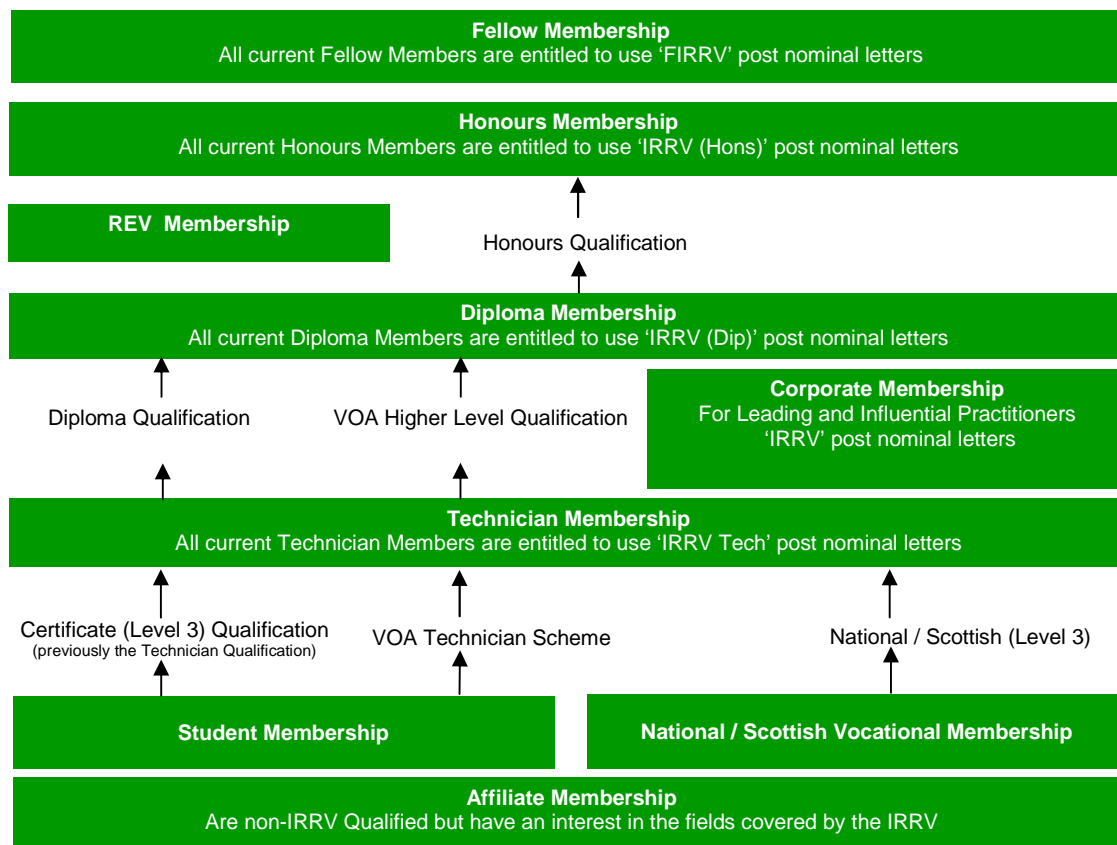


Categories of Membership and Fees

Categories of Membership

Fellow Membership for Honours members who contribute to specific IRRV activities

Honours Members have passed or been exempted from the Full Professional or Honours qualification

REV Membership for practising Valuers

Diploma Members have passed the Diploma qualification

Corporate Membership for Leading and Influential Practitioners

Technician Members have passed the Technician qualification

Graduate Members hold a BSc in Estates Management and are working towards the IRRV Test of Professional Competence

Student Members are studying for IRRV qualifications

QCF/SVQ Candidate Members are working for QCF/SVQs

Affiliate Members are non-IRRV qualified but have an interest in the fields covered by IRRV

Fellow Retired Members who were previously Honours members and have retired from professional work

Retired Members have retired from professional work

Honorary Members have rendered special service to IRRV
